

# VEHICLE

## EXPORTATION DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1. Original Title or Original Manufacturer of Origin. If the original is not available a certified copy o the Original Title notarized by Department of Motor Vehicle of the State in which the vehicle is registered. When the Manufacturer Certificate the Origin is used, the original bill of sale must be presented in the owner package and a copy in all others. Second assignment on MCO must be notarized.
2. A notarized Power of Attorney signed by ultimate purchase (owner, not representative or agent) of the vehicle. This is not required if the owner is presenting documents himself. Power of Attorney can be notarized outside the United States only if the country is part of The Hague Conference on private International Law, otherwise document most be notarized by the US Embassy in that country.
3. Identification for the owner and the person presenting the export documents. A valid driver license or passport (copies accepted) with signature. If the vehicle title or MCO is in the name of the company, corporate records identifying the person signing the Power of Attorney as an authorized officer of the corporation are required. (copy of Corporate documents).
4. An airline air waybill with the year, make, model and Vehicle Identification Number. Typed AWBL issued by Freight Forwarder or Consolidators will not be accepted.
5. A warehouse receipt from the exporting airline. The warehouse receipt must contain the VIN.
6. A Shipper Export Declaration (SED) or Automated Export System(AES) number on the AWBL with the vehicle description and VIN. This will only apply if the value of the vehicle is \$ 2,500.00 and above.
7. One Original set and three copies market Air Cargo, CBP and Filer are required. The only original document that must be included is CBP copy is the Power of Attorney.
8. All documents presented must be in English, certified translations accepted.

Documents must be presented in the order requested above. Self propelled vehicle included automobiles, trucks, tractors, buses, motorcycles, mini-bikes, go karts, motor homes, agricultural machinery, construction and or special equipment and any other vehicle designed for running on land but not on rails.
